 - e) The Prime Proposer or JV must possess a valid State of California Contractors
 State License Board (CLSB) Certification ASB (Asbestos Certification) in
 accordance with the provisions of Division 3, Chapter 9 of the Business and
 Professions Code.

QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS: (Questions paraphrased for clarity.)

Q1:	We are having a hard time getting LBE subcontractors to participate. May we get more time to response to the RFQ?
A1:	Yes. Please see CHANGES TO SUBMITTAL DEADLINE above.
Q2:	We believe that CSLB C-22 – Asbestos Abatement Contractor license more than fulfills the requirements in CSLB ASB – Asbestos Certification. May we respectfully request the removal of CSLB ASB – Asbestos Certification from the Minimum Qualifications?
A2:	Please see CHANGES TO THE RFQ Section above.
Q3:	If we list an LBE subcontractor with 13.5% participation, are we exempt from conducting CMD LBE Good Faith Outreach Efforts?
A3:	LBE requirement is 10% for the total value of the contract. CMD is confirming if a proposer/bidder seeks to waive/qualify for the LBE good faith option, they can do so by utilizing certificated LBE sub-contractors/sub-consultants to perform 13.5% of the contract's total value. A proposer/bidder must list a certified Small or Micro LBEs subcontractor to meet the LBE participation requirement (An SF-PUC LBE or an SBA certified LBE could not be listed to meet the LBE requirement. For all CMD related questions, proposer may contact CMD Contract Compliance Officer at Finbarr.Jewell@sfgov.org.
Q4:	We provide environmental testing, monitoring, and clearances. Could our firm be listed as a sub on a proposal? Or is there another RFQ for these services?
A4:	We have a separate RFQ for those services. Another round of RFQ for that type of services is anticipated in about 2 or 3 years from now.
