San Francisco Public Works (Public Works), a department of the City and County of San Francisco (City), seeks to award one grant to a fully established 501(c)(3) non-profit entity based in San Francisco through the evaluation and selection process as described in the RFP.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: San Francisco Public Works seeks a nonprofit partner to support workforce participants in developing careers beyond the program by connecting them to employment and apprenticeship opportunities at Public Works, other public agencies, non-profit partners, and private companies. Workforce participants will provide pressure washing services on designated sidewalks and hotspots in San Francisco to ensure clean citywide alleys, sidewalks, and rights-of-way. The Maximum Budget Request is \$506,107 for a term of 12 months with an option to extend for a maximum of 24 additional months.
