


### **About San Francisco Public Works**

Pressure Washing Workforce Development

#### **Eligibility (Minimum Qualifications)**:

- 501(c)(3) nonprofit based in San Francisco
- 2 years of experience providing workforce development to the target population
- 2 years of experience placing participants in unsubsidized, long-term employment
- 1 year of experience sidewalk cleaning
- 1 year of experience delivering programming at a similar size and scale of the proposed project
- 2 years of experience working in communities with limited English proficiency
- Maximum Grant Amount: \$506,107
- Anticipated # of Awards: 1

Pressure Washing Workforce Development

### **Workforce Development**

Support workforce participants in developing careers beyond the program by connecting them to employment and apprenticeship opportunities at Public Works, other public agencies, non-profit partners, and private companies. 2 hours/month

**Intended Participants:** San Francisco residents who are eligible to work but face barriers to employment, especially those in economically disadvantaged neighborhoods and communities.

2 outreach events 

**Training:** The grantees will provide employment readiness and job search activities that will support the successful transition of participants to unsubsidized employment after program completion. At least **two** work hours per employee per month must be dedicated to workforce development. Workshop examples include:

- Resume writing
- Job search skills
- Interview skills
- Job application skills

- Using online services to find and apply for jobs
- Conflict management
- De-escalation techniques



Pressure Washing Workforce Development

Workforce (continued)

**Transition to Unsubsidized Employment:** Support workforce participants in developing careers beyond the program by connecting them to employment and apprenticeship opportunities at Public Works, other public agencies, non-profit partners, and private companies.

- Participants must exit program within twelve (12) months of employment with the program
- Place at a minimum 35% of workforce development participants in full-time positions within six months of exiting the program



Pressure Washing Workforce Development

### **Pressure Washing Services:**

- Provide pressure washing services ("Services") on designated sidewalks and hotspots in San Francisco to ensure clean citywide alleys, sidewalks, and rights-of-way.
- Pressure washing shall be defined as the proactive use of high-pressure water spray to remove dust, dirt, grime, stickers, chewing gum and other debris from citywide refuse and the immediate sidewalk area surrounding each receptacle.




Pressure Washing Workforce Development

**Staffing Schedule and Crew Participants:** Grantee shall perform all Services Monday through Sunday, with a crew of at least three (3) workers and one (1) full time equivalent supervisor.

- Grantee shall be required to perform Services
  Monday through Sunday, 7 days per week.
  Cleaning staff shall be available to perform
  services 3 p.m. to 1:30 a.m.
- Service expected to begin by August 1, 2023







Pressure Washing Workforce Development

### **Community Engagement**

- Coordinate meetings on an as-needed basis with San Francisco Public Works and neighborhood stakeholders as required to engage the community in discussion on litter reduction to encourage community pride.
- Gather information through surveys, discussions, or other methods of obtaining feedback in the Service Area to report to Public Works representative.

### **Reporting and Data Collection:**

Weekly, monthly, and quarterly service and workforce development details are required, including:

- Area serviced, time of service, daily crew/supervisor numbers
- Workforce participant demographics, training, and work hours and placement





Appendix F: Grant Agreement - Insurance Requirements - Termination for Convenience

# **Insurance Requirements**

### **General Liability**

Covers claims arising due to damage or injury during performance of your duties or business. Cannot be waived.. Not less than \$1,000,000 each occurrence and \$2,000,000 general aggregate for Bodily Injury and Property Damage, including Contractual Liability, Personal Injury, Products and Completed Operations.



### **Commercial Auto**

Required any time a grantee will be driving onto city property or using a vehicle to perform any services under the contract. Not less than \$1,000,000 each occurrence Combined Single Limit for Bodily Injury and Property Damage, including Owned, Non-Owned and Hired auto coverage, as applicable.

### **Workers Compensation**

Required by organizations with one or more employees. Waiver of Subrogation is also required. In statutory amounts, with Employers' Liability Limits not less than \$1,000,000 each accident, injury, or illness.
