Bid Discounts

San Francisco Micro and Small LBE Prime Contractors will receive a 10% bid discount for this project. SF LBE Prime contractors that apply for the bid discount must be certified by the bid due date.

A 5% bid discount may apply to any Bid from an SF SBA-LBE. The 5% bid discount for SF SBA-LBEs, however, will not be applied if it would adversely affect an SF Small-LBE or Micro-LBE.

LBE Subcontracting Participation Requirement

The LBE Subcontractor Participation Requirement for this project is 25%.

Only Contract Monitoring Division certified SF Small-LBEs and Micro-LBEs can be utilized to comply with the LBE Subcontractor Participation Requirement. A listing of the LBE-certified firms is available on the CMD website.

SF LBE subcontractors must be certified on the bid due date *and* they must be certified in the areas or scope of work that they are being listed to perform. For example, to be get credit for using an LBE subcontractor for traffic control, the sub-contractor must be LBE-certified as a micro or small LBE for traffic control.

Good Faith Efforts Requirements

Bidders should also submit documented good faith efforts. There are three approaches available to demonstrate good faith outreach to SF LBE-certified firms.

- Under Approach A, the Prime Proposer must exceed the project's LBE participation requirement by 35%. For this project, 35% of the 25% sub-participation requirement is 33.75%
- Under Approach B, the Prime must list an SF Micro-LBE subcontractor on its Bid that have not been listed on its last five (5) most recent City awarded contracts that has an LBE sub participation requirement.
- Under Approach C, the Prime must earn at least 50 points by demonstrating that it negotiated with LBEs in good faith. The Prime must submit supporting documentation as outlined under this approach at the time of bid in order to earn points.
