# 3. Overview

This project involves the renovation of the Japantown Peace Plaza located at 1610 Geary Boulevard, San Francisco between Geary Boulevard and Post Street. The plaza is a major cultural landmark in San Francisco and onsite structures like the Peace Pagoda monument are historic. The outdoor plaza is over 30,000 square feet in area and built over a parking garage. The scope of work includes demolition of the existing plaza down the structural roof slab, seismic retrofit of structural concrete, installation of new below grade drainage and waterproofing. The plaza will be completed with new pavers, landscape planters and irrigation, decorative walls, curbs and railings, lighting and electrical systems. Architectural work includes the construction of a new storage building. The existing buildings at the Japan Center Mall that front the edge of Peace Plaza as well as the parking garage below shall be occupied and used by the public during construction.

  - ii. the construction of at least 1,000 sq. ft. of roof top plaza that includes roof waterproofing, pavers, irrigation and drainage.
  - iii. construction work on a historic concrete building.
  - iv. seismic retrofit of existing concrete structures.
  - v. construction in an existing building or facility that is occupied and open to the public during construction with limited or restricted site access.
  - Submit sufficient information on the Safety Prequalification Form and additional documentation as necessary (per Section 00 45 14 Bidder's Safety Record) to demonstrate to the satisfaction of the City that the Prime Contractor substantiates its record of safe performance on construction projects.
  - Submit sufficient information on the Bidder's Qualifications form (Section 00 45 13),
  - j. Experience statement requirements for key staff, additional qualifications for the sub-contractors and equipment suppliers can be found in Specification Section 00 21 13 Instructions to Bidders.
- k. <u>Anticipated Commencement of the Work</u>: Spring 2024.
- I. <u>Construction Duration</u>: 500 consecutive calendar days to Substantial Completion, and 60 consecutive calendar days to Final Completion. See General Requirements Specifications section 00 72 00 for more information.
- m. <u>Liquidated Damages</u>: \$4,000/day after time limit for Substantial Completion; and \$1,000/day after time limit for Final Completion
