The Stern Grove Playground Renovation includes the complete renovation of an existing children's play area located at Sigmund Stern Recreation Grove. The project site is located off of Sloat Boulevard, near the intersection with 21st Avenue. The scope includes demolition; stump removal; removal and disposal of hazardous materials; soil and sand; grading; drainage; soil improvement; utility work; structural concrete work; paving; wooden boardwalk; new playground; fencing; planting and irrigation; and incidental work.

The scope includes hazardous materials abatement. Please see the Stern Grove Hazardous Materials Report dated June 26, 2012. Also, to be referenced for abatement requirements and submittals are specifications 01 35 44 Hazardous Building Materials Scope of Work and specifications 02 80 13 Hazardous Building Materials Remediation.

 - Prime Contractor must have successfully completed a minimum of three (3) site construction projects that include similar scope and complexity during the last five (5) years involving parks, playgrounds, and/or plazas with a minimum contract value of \$1,250,00 and a minimum of four (4) subcontracted trades for each project. At least one (1) of these projects shall include hazardous abatement. At least one (1) of these projects shall include a children's playground.

- f. Anticipated Commencement of the Work: April 2024.
- g. <u>Construction Duration</u>: 240 consecutive calendar days to Substantial Completion, and

- h. <u>Liquidated Damages</u>: \$2,500/day after time limit for Substantial Completion; and \$625/day after time limit for Final Completion

- j. <u>Clean Construction Site</u>: Pursuant to SF Admin. Code Section 6.25, "Clean Construction" is required.
