Notices regarding Addenda and other RFQ changes will also be posted in the Supplier Portal.

The LBE Subconsulting Participation Requirement established for this project is **25%**. However, San Francisco Public Works encourage responses from certified City and County of San Francisco LBE's as Prime Contractors.

A contract awarded pursuant to this Solicitation shall have a not to exceed ("NTE") amount of \$1,000,000 for the total allowable maximum term. Each master agreement will have a five (5) year term with Contract Service Orders (CSO), or tasks issued during the first four years only.

Public Works reserves the right to change the number of contracts, the contract amount, and have the sole discretion to extend the Contract duration to be awarded consistent with City contracting requirements.

Since this is an "As-Needed" contract, award of a master agreement does not guarantee that the selected firms will perform all or any portion of the services described in this RFQ, nor does it guarantee that the maximum amount will be expended. The maximum contract dollar amount does not represent a guaranteed revenue source for any of the selected firms.
