The City intends to award up to four (4) master agreements with a not to exceed value of up to \$800,000 for each master agreement. Public Works reserves the right to change the number of contracts, the contract amount, and have the sole discretion to extend the Contract duration to be awarded consistent with City contracting requirements.
