Bidder shall submit with its Bid:

- (2) a completed and executed Release and Waiver Agreement (§ 00 45 16)
- (3) a completed Bidder's Safety Record form (§ 00 45 14)

Bidder's Qualifications (Section 00 21 13):

- 1. Possess a 'B' license.
- 2. Prime Contractor shall have successfully completed a minimum of two (2) projects that include similar scope and complexity during the last six (6) years involving elevator modernization, replacement, or new installation with a minimum contract value of \$2M and at least with two (2) subcontract trades.



Subcontractor Qualifications Spec. § 14 21 23

Elevator Subcontractor Qualifications (Section 14 21 23, subsection 1.08):

- 1. Elevator Subcontractor shall have completed at least 3 sequentially phased modernization projects of comparable scope and complexity in the last five (5) years.
- 2. Elevator Subcontractor shall occupy an office within fifty (50) miles of the project site and directly employ no fewer than three (3) qualified, State-licensed service mechanics whose primary residence is within fifty (50) miles of the project site.

Prime Contractor's Project Manager: Min. 10 years of experience managing building construction projects, successfully completed at least 2 projects in the last 6 years with a min. contract value of \$2M and with a min. of 2 subcontract trades.

Elevator Modernization Foreman: Possess **a** valid Certified Competent Conveyance Mechanic license for a min. of 10 years in the State of California.


Temporary Facilities and Controls Spec. § 01 50 00

Work Restrictions:

- 1. The building will be occupied and operational during the Work of this Contract. The Contractor shall take all necessary precautions and implement mitigation controls to minimize disruption to occupied areas. Contractor shall maintain access to the following areas at all times during construction:
 - Building main entrances and exits
 - Accessible path of travel
 - Parking area entrances and exits
 - Garbage pick-up locations
- 1. If vehicular or pedestrian access is limited at any time during construction including access to properties adjacent to the limit of work, the Contractor shall notify the City Representative in writing and obtain approval prior to closing vehicular or pedestrian access.

Noise Control and Mitigation:

To minimize construction noise and vibration impact, all high noise and vibration construction activities occurring on a business day shall occur between 7AM - 9AM. During special events, high noise activities may be prohibited, contractor shall coordinate with facilities engineers prior to any work requiring equipment that may result in high noises that could impact operations.

Hazardous Material Abatement:

Hazardous building material removal and abatement work per specification Section 01 35 44 – Building Related Hazardous Materials must be performed after 5pm on weekdays and from 7am to 5pm on weekends.

The Contractor shall coordinate and schedule hazardous building material testing, surveying, removal, and abatement work with the City Representative prior to performing such work.
