

### **Project Description**

The project is to modernize two existing service elevators at San Francisco General Hospital, Building 5. The scope of work to be completed under this contract includes, but are not limited, to the following:

- 1. Demolition
- 2. Hazardous material abatement
- 3. Elevator machine, equipment, and control panel replacement
- 4. Hall fixtures, buttons, and signage replacement
- 5. Electrical / lighting / mechanical system modification
- 6. Fire alarm system modification

The project scope of work also includes the following delegated designs:

- 1. Fire alarm modification
- 2. Elevator equipment anchor, support, and attachment

In case of discrepancies, the official Contract Documents and addenda, if any, shall govern.

### **Bidder shall submit with its Bid:**

- (1) a completed Bidder's Qualifications form (§ 00 45 13)
- (2) a completed and executed Release and Waiver Agreement (§ 00 45 16)
- (3) a completed Bidder's Safety Record form (§ 00 45 14)

#### **Bidder's Qualifications (Section 00 21 13):**

- 1. Possess a 'B' license.
- 2. Prime Contractor shall have successfully completed a minimum of 3 projects in the last 10 years involving elevator modernization, replacement, or new installation
  - 1. At least one of the projects shall involve work in an occupied and operational OSHPD / HCAI Type 1, Type 1R, or Type 2 building substantially completed within the past 10 years with a total construction cost of \$500K or greater; alternatively, a completion of a series of individual separately permitted OSHPD / HCAI projects with a total cumulative total construction cost of \$750K or greater.
  - 2. At least two projects shall involve new construction or renovation scopes with each project having a total construction cost of \$1M or greater

## **Subcontractor Qualifications**

Spec. § 00 21 13

#### **Elevator Subcontractor Qualifications (Section 00 21 13):**

- Possess a California C-11 license.
- 2. Elevator Subcontractor shall have completed at least 3 elevator modernization, replacement, or new installation projects with a minimum contract value of \$500K in similar or greater scope and complexity in the last 10 years.
- 3. Elevator Subcontractor shall occupy an office within fifty (50) miles of the project site and directly employ no fewer than three (3) qualified, State-licensed service mechanics whose primary residence is within fifty (50) miles of the project site.

### **Contractor Experience Requirements**

Experience Statements (submit within 10 working days after the date of the City's notification of the lowest bidder):

**Prime Contractor's Project Manager:** Experience working in private or public hospital facilities under HCAI jurisdiction in California and successfully completed a min. of one HCAI Type 1, Type 1R, or Type 2 hospital building construction projects similar or greater in scope and complexity in the last 10 year.

**Prime Contractor's Site Superintendent:** Experience working in private or public hospital facilities under HCAI jurisdiction in California and successfully completed a min. of one HCAI Type 1, Type 1R, or Type 2 hospital building construction projects similar or greater in scope and complexity in the last 10 year.

**Elevator Modernization Project Manager:** Minimum of 3 years of direct experience coordinating elevator modernizations of comparable size and complexity.

**Elevator Modernization Superintendent:** Minimum of 10 years of experience supervising field teams in execution of elevator modernizations of comparable size and complexity.

**Elevator Modernization Mechanics (3):** shall have successfully completed a minimum of 5 modernization projects of comparable size and complexity.

## Special Project Procedures for Zuckerberg San Francisco General

Spec. § 01 35 13

Zuckerberg San Francisco General Hospital & Trauma Center (ZSFG) requires the contractor to obtain permits, attend training / orientation, submit work plans and follow other requirements. The procurement of these items is the responsibility of the Contractor.

- Mandatory Safety Hospital Orientation Seminar only workers that have completed this safety seminar are allowed to work on site.
- Combined Contractor's Work Permit (CCWP)— must be obtained prior to starting any work on site.
- Infection Control Construction Permit (ICCP) must be obtained prior to starting any abatement, demolition, or construction work.
- Hot Work Permit
- Shutdown Permit
- Evidence of Baseline TB Test and Flu Shot contractor shall ensure all workers have a baseline TB test performed within 3 months of starting work at ZSFG and receive seasonal flu shots.
- **Daily Check-in of All Contractor Personnel** all contractor and subcontractor must sign-in with the Service Building watch desk at the beginning of each shift. The watch desk will provide temporary "contractor badge" which is to be displayed on each worker while on ZSFG Campus.

### **Temporary Facilities and Controls**

Spec. § 01 50 00

**Work Hours:** 7:00am to 5:00pm Monday – Friday (unless otherwise stated in other sections of the Project Manual)

Contractor Access and Staging Plan: must be submitted and approved prior to commencement of work

#### **Work Restrictions:**

- The building will be occupied and operational during the work of this contract. The contractor shall take all necessary precautions and implement mitigation controls to minimize disruption to occupied areas.
- 2. The contractor shall maintain access to the building at all times during construction, including building entrances, accessible path of travel, and egress.
- 3. The Contractor must complete the modernization work of each service elevator individually and in sequential order. At least one elevator shall be in service at all times.


