**QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS:**

(Questions were paraphrased for clarity.)

<b>Q1:</b>	<b>Are consultants expected to include a full subconsultant team or utilize San Francisco Public Work's approved bench? Can subconsultants be added after the contract is awarded?</b>
A1:	<i>Since there is no LBE subconsulting requirement for contracts awarded under this solicitation, proposers do not need to name specific subconsultants at the time of proposal submission if those arrangements are not yet finalized. However, proposers must still describe their deployment approach, team structure, and the roles and qualifications required to perform the work in their proposal. If subconsultants are needed as part of the team to satisfy the scope of work requirements or other RFQ requirements, then they should be listed with the proposal. Specific subconsultants may be identified later during contract negotiations, as long as they align with the proposer’s submitted approach and meet qualifications acceptable to the City.</i>
